

Curriculum Overview: Two Year Plan

The Augustine Institute Distance Education Program offers great flexibility to meet your individual needs. You can take 2 to 3 classes each semester and complete your degree in 2 years or you can go at a slower pace, spreading out your classes over 3 to 5 years. Below is the curriculum for those who desire to complete the Master's Degree within 2 years. Again, you also may complete the degree at your own pace understanding that this is the order the courses will be made available. You may begin the program at any semester as it will rotate through again after the Summer 2 classes are over and begin with Fall 1.
