HOW TO APPLY OR REQUEST MORE INFORMATION:

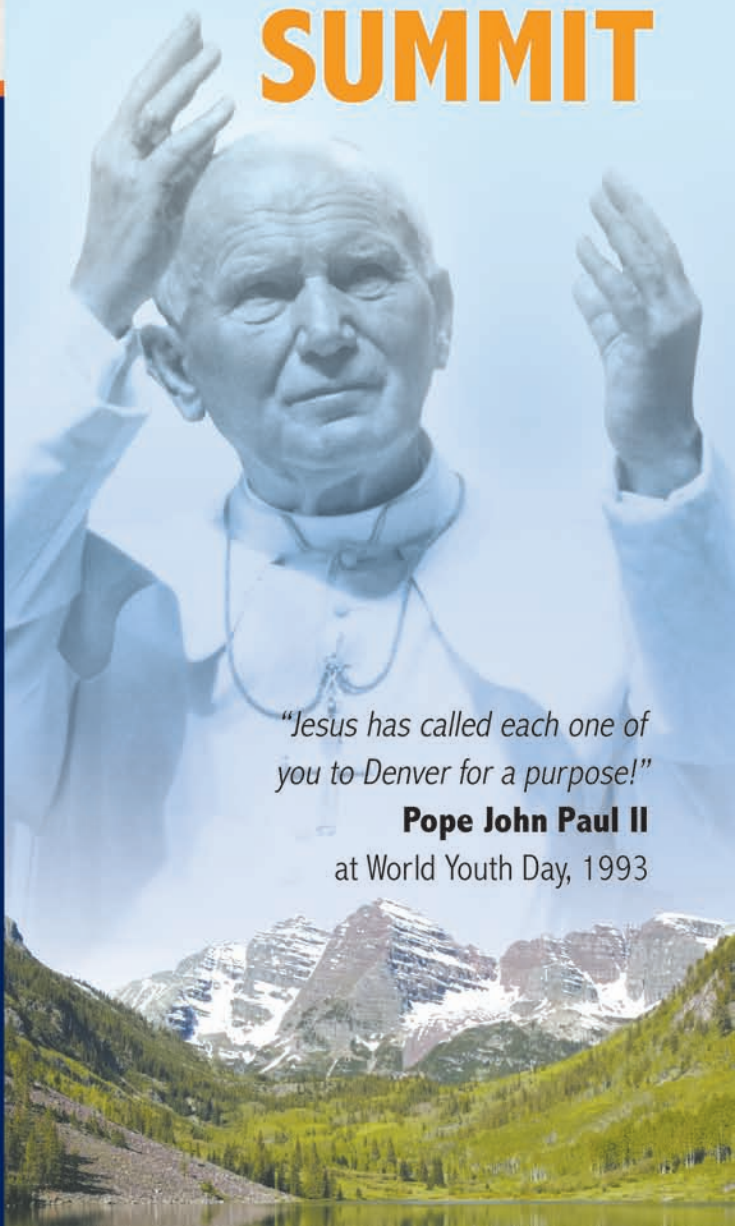

Dates and location: The Augustine Institute College Student Summit will be held at magnificent Camp St. Malo Catholic Center in Allenspark, CO for 8 days from Monday evening, May 18 through Tuesday morning, May 26.

Cost: \$1,600 per student, which includes: course instruction; lodging for 8 nights with one roommate in a room with two double-beds; three meals per day; snacks; and transportation between Denver International Airport and Camp St. Malo Catholic Center. The cost does not cover any other expenses.

Scholarships: The Augustine Institute is offering eight, \$500 competitive scholarships to students whose parish is willing to make a matching \$500 contribution on the student's behalf. (So, if your parish contributes \$500 and you win one of the scholarships, the cost of the program for you will only be \$600 rather than \$1,600.)
